## Administrative Highlights



### Anniversary, Partnerships & Structural Growth

-  PAI celebrated the sixth anniversary of its founding on Nov. 26, 2010. Since its founding, PAI's board has grown 400 percent, membership has grown 1100 percent and staff has grown over 500 percent.
-  In 2010, Pax Americana Institute welcomed a new Fellow from New York, who now operates a satellite office for the institute in NYC.
-  After launching *The Collegiate Conservative* in 2009—the nation's most comprehensive collegiate journal for the advancement of conservative thought—PAI welcomed the official partnerships of *The Stanford Review* at Stanford University and *The Purdue Review* at Purdue University in the fall of 2010. The staff of both conservative newspapers will serve as regular contributors to PAI's *The Collegiate Conservative*.
-  PAI entered into a publication partnership with [The Reality News](#) and now contributes regularly to every edition of Wisconsin's most circulated conservative newspaper.


### Institute Operations

-  For the first time in five years, operations and outreach necessitated the creation of a Chief Operations Officer. The position was filled for only five months, however; an active search for another COO continues.

## Statewide Conservatism

-  In the spring, PAI acquired [WisconsinConservatives.com](#), a non-profit headquartered in Milwaukee, and re-launched the site anew with: a Statewide Calendar of Conservative Events; a Master Directory of Wisconsin's Conservative Organizations; a Trove of Wisconsin Policy Research; and outlets to download [The Collegiate Conservative](#), [The Wisconsin Conservative Digest](#).
-  Pax Americana Institute negotiated and now hosts a commercial statewide distribution network for [The Reality News](#) newspaper and



*The Digest*, both of which publish PAI's commentary and policy proposals bi-weekly and bi-monthly, respectively. Overnight, conservative print publications blanketed the state, providing Wisconsinites with real solutions to rival the fantastical, impracticalities of the left.

-  In the winter and spring, PAI hosted a series of leadership summits for conservative leaders from established conservative organizations in WI, grassroots organizations and TEA Party coalitions. The summits resulted in new channels of communication, resource sharing, and rapid event planning. These summits helped pave the way for an organized conservative movement to elect a right-of-center government in WI in November!
